Call for Workshops

Each year, Echo Parenting & Education hosts the "Changing the Paradigm Conference" to bring together researchers or specialists and those who work with children and families to translate cutting edge science and innovation into practice. The conference draws over 300 parents, teachers, administrators, social service workers and therapists who are all hungry to learn best practices from the "frontiers of innovation."

Call for Workshops

Echo Parenting & Education invites proposals for concurrent workshops sessions to be held on Wednesday, March 16 and Thursday, March 17, 2016. Interactive presentations should be designed to last **60-75 minutes** including any Q&A time and fit within one of the following tracks:

- Childhood trauma and toxic stress
- Trauma-informed schools

- \circ $\,$ Body-based regulation and healing $\,$
- Parent & youth voices

Guidelines for Submission

There are different categories for presentations: Workshops, Learning Circles, and Panel Discussions. Our goal is to have a diverse program in both subject matter and type of presentation.

Full workshop proposal should include:

- Cover Page *(attached)*
- Biographical summary for each presenter, including credentials (100 words max)
- Handouts and PowerPoint presentations. We ask that PowerPoints be limited to 30 slides.
- 200–500 word expanded description, which includes:
 - o Three learning objectives for the workshop
 - o Presentation methods
 - o Geographic area & population served
 - o Innovative elements or unique impacts
 - o Best practices or strategies highlighted in the workshop
 - $_{\odot}$ Any data or evaluation findings that will be shared
- Describe specific audio-visual needs or set-up requirements

Selection Criteria

Presentations will be selected based on:

- Relevance to conference theme
- Variety added to topics/viewpoints/approaches represented at conference
- Degree of anticipated audience interaction and participation
- Innovative nature of content

Submission Deadline

Proposals must be received by Friday, September 18, 2015

- The Conference Advisory Committee and Echo Parenting & Education staff will review all presentations
- The Contact Person will be notified of the final decision via email and/or telephone by November 16th, 2015. If your presentation is chosen and you are notified, you will need to confirm your participation with Echo Parenting & Education by December 11, 2015
- After December 11, 2015, changes in your presentation's content (PowerPoint, information, handouts, etc.) and speakers (adding or subtracting) will need to be reviewed by Echo Parenting & Education and the Conference Advisory Committee
