Senator Durbin:

Thank you for your letter, jointly signed by Ranking Member Danny K. Davis, Subcommittee on Human Resources, House Committee on Ways and Means, requesting that the Government Accountability Office review how selected states identify and treat children and families who have experienced or are at risk of experiencing trauma.

GAO accepts your request as work that is within the scope of its authority. At the current time we anticipate that staff with the required skills will be available to initiate an engagement in about three months. Your request has been assigned to Ms. Barbara D. Bovbjerg, Managing Director, Education, Workforce, and Income Security. Closer to the time GAO can start the engagement, Ms. Bovbjerg or a member of her team will contact Mr. Max Kanner to confirm that this request continues to be your priority for us. As applicable, we will also be in contact with the cognizant Inspector General's office to ensure that we are not duplicating efforts. If an issue arises during this coordination, we will consult with you regarding its resolution.
