Through this training, organizational leaders will be able to:

- 1) Gain insight and tools on ACEs, toxic stress, ACE screening, and unique populations experiencing ACEs to assess their local communities, to then 2) Identify and engage community-based services to provide a warm handoff for patients and their families to gain access to ongoing support in the community.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

1. Define Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) and their prevalence, health disparities in these data, toxic stress physiology, and related impacts on health, including underlying biological mechanisms.
2. Identify how to introduce and integrate ACEs and toxic stress screening into clinical care, aligning with trauma-informed care principles.
3. Describe special populations at increased risk of ACEs and toxic stress.
4. Identify at least three strategies to facilitate warm handoffs and referrals to community resources.
