## TOP THREE HEALTH RELATED NEEDS

Benton Franklin Community Health Alliance members, additional community partners, and interested stakeholders were invited to a planning session to help select the top health-related needs of the community. The over 50 community partners in attendance included stakeholders from all four local healthcare systems, public health, emergency responders, behavioral health, student nursing programs, local chambers, long term care facilities, and other service oriented community based organizations. Those in attendance participated in structured, facilitated activities to review the data and organize them into overarching categories. The group then prioritized those categories and identified the top three health-related needs for the community.
