According to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' Office on Women's Health, 55% – 99% of women in substance use treatment and 85% – 95% of women in the public mental health system report a history of trauma, with the abuse most commonly having occurred in childhood. Yet, most in the industry still struggle to understand the impacts of trauma on brain development in a concrete and tangible way.
