

Percent of women with a live birth who experienced individual childhood hardships




The Maternal and Infant Health Assessment (MIHA) is an annual population based survey of women with a recent live birth with a sample size of n= 13,663 in 2011-12. Percentages and 95% confidence intervals are weighted to represent all women with a live birth in 2011 and 2012 in California.

- Autoimmune disease


Reproductive Health/Sexual Behavior concerns(based on research from the CDC)

- Teen Pregnancy


Behavioral Health Concerns

- Interpersonal Violence
- Risky Sexual Behaviors
- Suicide

Depression in mothers, like any other adult has roots in ACEs...



1 in 5 women report prenatal or postpartum depressive symptoms
