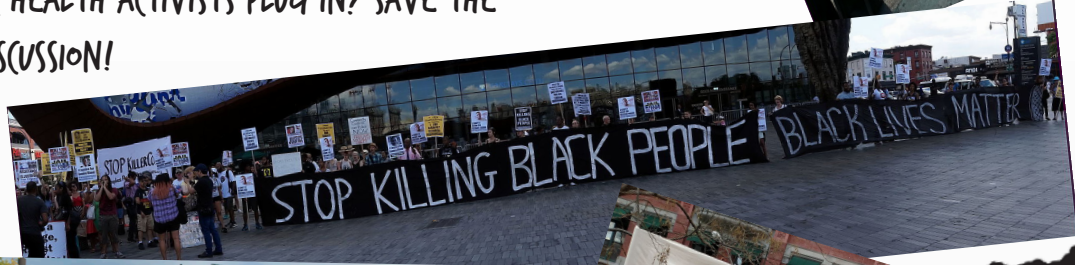


BLACK LIVES MATTER: FROM MOMENT TO MOVEMENT
