

KEYNOTE: JIM SPORLEDER

Sporleder retired in 2014 as Principal of Lincoln High School in Walla Walla, WA. Under Jim's leadership, Lincoln High School became a "Trauma Informed" school, gaining Jim national attention due to a dramatic drop in out-of-school suspensions, increased graduation rates, and the number of students going on to post-secondary education. These dramatic changes at Lincoln caught the attention of Jamie Redford, who spent a year filming the documentary Paper Tigers, which tells the Lincoln story. The documentary was released at the May 2015 Seattle International Film Festival and received positive reviews.

Jim is currently working as a trauma-informed coach/consultant based in Walla Walla, WA. His travels as a consultant, keynote speaker, presenter, and trainer have taken him all over the United States.

Jim is married, and has three daughters and seven granddaughters. In his spare time, Jim enjoys fishing, hunting, but most of all... spending time with family.
