Increasing Access to Emergency Child Care Bridge Program



One of the primary barriers to recruiting and retaining families seeking to provide foster care is the lack of access to child care. California established the Emergency Child Care Bridge Program (SB 89, Chapter 24, Statutes of 2017) to increase access to child care and enable more families to become foster parents.

This webinar will provide an overview of the bridge program, including the main components of time-limited child care vouchers and child care navigators. Panelists will share outcomes and lessons learned from a recent child care pilot and local implementation of the bridge program. We will also discuss current legislative proposals to augment the bridge program and hear from a caregiver about his experiences with the child care program.
