## CA Earned Tax Credit Eligibility

The California Department of Public Health's Maternal, Child, and Adolescent Health Division (MCAH) has created a toolkit for use by local agencies to promote California's tax credits including the California Earned Income Tax Credit (CalEITC), the Young Child Tax Credit (YCTC), the Federal Earned Income Tax Credit and the Federal Child Tax Credit. These tax credits are available for families earning under \$30,000 per year, including those without a Social Security Number but who may have an Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN). **You may be eligible for CA tax credits if:**

- ✓ You're at least 18 years old, or have a qualifying child; and
- ✓ You earn less than \$30,000 per year; and
- ✓ You have a SSN or ITIN
