She teaches courses in the undergraduate public health program, and her work primarily focuses on the social and behavioral foundations of public health. Her research interest is in addressing issues of equity and access to quality healthcare to improve the quality of life for people often negatively impacted by health disparities. She has authored multiple publications including, *Assessing Disparities in Asthma Among Children of a Large Metropolitan Area: The Childhood Opportunity Index*. She received a Doctor of Education in Curriculum and Instruction from Florida International University and Master of Public Health from the University of West Florida.
