Brief Recap of from the previous month:

- We met on June 22, 2022 as our 2nd workgroup meeting.
- We continue to look to identify new and missing participants.
- Group briefly discussed recent mass shootings from the perspective of PACES and the importance of this work.
- Group continued to focus on professional development, identifying a goal of a workshop in the fall and leading to a bigger seminar in the Spring.

To be a community driven workgroup focused on advocacy, education, awareness related to the science of Positive and Adverse Childhood Experiences (PACES). This workgroup is committed to exploring the role we play as a community in supporting positive experiences and mitigating adverse experiences.

- Build off of this training
 - Canned 2 hour that we can take anywhere and others can use in the community.
 - Interest in other facilitators so we can have some rolling facilitators for future trainings or to offer to specific targeted groups.
 - Asking those interested in offering the training to come to the September 9th training.
- Spring Seminar
 - Target 150 probably 9am – 3pm.
 - Need a location and date
 - Susan – include topic on how to “administer” ACES questionnaire to clients and then be able to translate it into conversation.
 - **Nikki – we could also incorporate the PCE questionnaire in this.**
 - **Abraham – topic on Relational Health.**
 - **Abraham – possible topic on the relationship between ACES and Addiction.**
 - **Do we need break out sessions (e.g., Clinical Track, Non Clinical track).**
- Separate Community Activity that we want to discuss in this group as it would be viewed as a community activity from this workgroup: Book Discussion from the Book “What Happened to You: Conversations of Trauma, Resilience and Healing” by Oprah Winfrey and Dr. Bruce Perry.
