Genet Stewart - Presentation

- Genet talked about her role at the CBHC as the Director of Strategic Initiatives. Represents a brand new initiative focused systemically on how to change the lives of children impacted by racial disparity using the social determinants of health as a framework.
- CBHC committed 6 years of funding to initiative – One Hillsborough.
- One Hillsborough's goal is to improve collaboration, communication between different systems and break down silos to better serve the communities in South Seminole Heights, MLK / East Tampa, Palm River / Progress Village.
- Contract Managers assigned to each of the 3 zip codes. Focused on listening to and engaging those communities.
- Project is in its first year and the next step is planning to put out funding requests specific to One Hillsborough in the next 6 months. One Hillsborough is separate of other programs at the CBHC.
- Planning to release an opportunity of provide wraparound supports for trauma informed schools targeting Frost and Giunta.
