 - b. Received SAMSHA grant to offer 12 free sessions of counseling to everyone- women, men, couples, families, children 9+. Starting community counseling center at sligh and Florida building

17. Dr. Fredrick Hicks, Early Learning Coalition

- a. ARPA funding was lost 10/1/2023- childcare centers are in a crisis
 - i. Teachers are leaving classrooms.
 - ii. Parents are facing difficulty choosing an affordable school option
 - iii. Parents deny raise to stay in eligibility range of aid/services
- b. Florida retained funds to distribute \$33 million to start & restore childcare initiatives
 - i. Councils of imagination- only care for children with unique abilities/adverse events right now but money has be allocated to put towards a new program
- c. Carved out \$2 million to create centers for unique abilities. Need to reach children before kindergarten

- d. Clients are above eligibility range. Community match money goes towards families who exceed eligibility. Can match local funding dollar for dollar for families over 150% of federal poverty level.
 - i. Will be asking for maximum donation for potential donors.
 - ii. Need to establish partnerships for Hillsborough county's future.
- e. Children summit 2 weeks ago- 5.5 million dollars lost of revenue is childcare is lost in FL
- f. Advised we reach out to state representatives to request money for students with trauma, unique abilities/sensitives
