The 2016 Midwest ACE Summit is a two-day conference that will bring people across the region together for learning about topics related to Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs).

The theme of this year's conference is *Healing Communities Together* and sessions will focus on addressing childhood trauma and promoting healing at a community level.

Keynote speakers for the 2016 Midwest ACE Summit will include **Dr. Roy Wade Jr.** and **Sam Simmons**, leading experts on adversity and health in urban and African American communities.

Dr. Henry Emmons, author of *The Chemistry of Calm* and *The Chemistry of Joy*, will lead a session on healing and resilience-building strategies and **Laura Porter** of the Foundation for Healthy Generations will facilitate the Summit's final plenary session.

Attendees will also be able to participate in several interactive breakout workshops and healing workshops of their choice. Breakout sessions will be on a variety of topics including: community-based and culturally-specific efforts to promote healing from trauma, creating trauma-informed schools and health care systems, healing ourselves (self-care), and more!
