This document contains the BRFS 2015 Adverse Childhood Experiences items: the 11 standard CDC items, introduction, and ending (saac_int to saac11, plus saac_end); the 8 state-added poverty & neglect items (saac21-saac28); and the 6 state-added resilience items (saac31-saac36).

Text in parentheses is optional, and is read at the interviewer's discretion. Uppercase text is for interviewer instructions, and is not read directly to respondents.) Angle brackets (> <) denote item numbers.

I'd like to ask you some questions about events that happened during your childhood. This information will allow us to better understand problems that may occur early in life, and may help others in the future.

This is a sensitive topic and some people may feel uncomfortable with these questions. At the end of this section, I will give you a phone number for an organization that can provide information and referral for these issues. Please keep in mind that you can ask me to skip any question you do not want to answer.

All questions refer to the time period before you were 18 years of age. Now, looking back before you were 18 years of age ...

(NOTE: R SHOULD REPORT ONLY ON PLACES WHERE THEY _HAD_ TO STAY WHILE HOMELESS, NOT WHILE VACATIONING, CAMPING, OR VISITING RELATIVES.)
