Family Support



The WCOC hosts a food pantry once a month. Families have access to shelf-stable items and fresh produce when available.



Families have access to gently used, washed clothes, through the Lifeworks closet. Shoes are available upon request.



Self-serve laundry services are available to HUSD families (by appointment).



Backpacks and basic school supplies are available to HUSD students upon request.



Parent education classes are offered; the topics include: positive parenting, internet safety, nutrition, self-care and mental health awareness.



Family Engagement opportunities such as museum days, skating and movie nights are offered throughout the year.

Physical Health

Credentialed school nurses provide nursing education, vision, and hearing, and site-based support.



Dental services provided include hygiene services to students with the goal to improve oral health.
