The film explores how Principal Sporleder's embrace of a new trauma-informed approach resulted not only in improved student behavior, but also significant, measureable improvement in students' academic performance. Grades went up while suspensions and expulsions virtually disappeared. This documentary traces the process, strategies and perspectives of staff and students at Lincoln High School. (*Not recommended for younger children due to strong language*)
