



Leadership Position Announcement

The Chadwick Center for Children and Families at Rady Children's Hospital-San Diego is seeking candidates for the **Director of Clinical Operations**.

This is a demanding leadership position overseeing the delivery of key clinical services of the Chadwick Center including the core child advocacy center functions for San Diego. The position includes support of Forensic and Medical Services staff, including a team of board certified Child Abuse Pediatricians; a Forensic Interviewing team; Child and Family Traumatic Stress Intervention (CFTSI) therapists; specialized Trauma Counseling therapists in three San Diego locations, using such evidence-based interventions as TF-CBT, CPP, PCIT, and Chadwick's TAP model; the KidSTART program, a specialized transdisciplinary team working with other hospital disciplines in three locations focused on children ages 0-5 with complex social-emotional, behavioral and developmental needs; and a well-established Kids and Teens in Court Program. This position is responsible for the clinical direction and operations, human resource management, contract compliance, and budget performance of these teams that total over 70 people. The Director of Clinical Operations actively participates in clinical grant and contract proposal writing and negotiations. This position is supported by key Chadwick administrative resources and a wide variety of hospital assets and colleagues.

In addition to these day to day responsibilities and active involvement in strategic planning and direction of the overall Chadwick Center, there is opportunity, based on expertise, interest, and time, to participate in other Chadwick grant and educational programs that do not report to the Director of Clinical Operations. These programs include the San Diego International Conference on Child and Family Maltreatment, Chadwick's SAMHSA-funded Category 2, National Child Traumatic Stress Network grant focused on expanding Trauma Informed Practice across the nation, the California Evidence Based Clearinghouse for Children Welfare (www.cebc4cw.org), the Western Regional Children's Advocacy Center supporting 13 western states, and ACTS, a grant from the State of California to infuse trauma-informed practice in child welfare systems across the state.

The ideal candidate will have academic training, experience and/or expertise in clinical program leadership of a similar sized organization (preferably a Child Advocacy Center), including evidence-based trauma treatment, trauma-informed practice, forensic interviewing, forensic medical services, and infant and young child mental health, implementation of the accrediting standards of the National Children's Alliance, and professional education in related subjects. Operationally the candidate must excel at budget and human resource management and operations management in complex organizational systems such as those found in Rady Children's Hospital.
