- ☐ Support San Diego State University Child, Family Development students' internship(s)
- ☐ Reply to requests within 3 days
- ☐ Strategic Plan oversight: promoting achievement of goals and periodic updating
- ☐ Term limits are 2 years, though members can serve consecutive terms
- ☐ Members can nominate themselves or be nominated by others
