WHAT IS RESTORATIVE JUSTICE?

"Restorative justice is a process to involve, to the extent possible, those who have a stake in an offense and to collectively identify and address harms, needs and obligations, in order to heal and put things right as possible." Zehr, H.



RJ IS AN APPROACH

DIFFERENCE BETWEEN RJ AND CJS?

They look a different set of questions They use a different kind of approach

Traditional Criminal Justice System (CJS)	Restorative Justice
What law was broken? What crime was committed?	What happened? What harm was caused?
Who broke the law?	How can that harm be repaired?
How should they be punished?	Who is responsible for this repair? Who is involved and affected by this?

RESTORATIVE JUSTICE IS NOT...

- RJ IS NOT ABOUT FORGIVENESS
- RJ IS NOT NECESSARILY AN ALTERNATIVE TO THE

CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM OR INCARCERATION.

- RJ IS NOT EXCLUSIVELY FOR YOUNG OFFENDERS AND LESS SERIOUS OFFENSES.
- RJ IS NOT A PARTICULAR PROGRAM OR A BLUEPRINT.
- RJ IS NOT EASY OR "JUST A SLAP ON THE WRIST".
- RJ does not always involve a meeting face-

TO-FACE.



RESEARCH AND RJ STUDIES AND META-ANALYSES

- > **Decrease** in recidivism (re-offending)
- High satisfaction rate regarding process and outcome for both the person who caused harm and the person who was harmed.
- > Increased positive perception of the CJS and its fairness
- > **Decrease** in feelings of revenge and fear.
- > **Decrease** in post-traumatic stress symptoms.
- Positive effects on physical/psychological health and sense of support.
- Cost-benefit analyses show that it saves time, saves judicial processing money & costs to society.
- Offending party is more likely to meet financial obligations through a restorative process (restitution is agreed upon).
- Increase in acceptance (by the person who cause harmed) of their sentence or conditions imposed by the courts.

RESTORATIVE PARTNERS – RJ DIVERSION PROGRAM

Restorative Partners is teaming up with the DA's office to develop and run a restorative justice program for adults. This program uses a specific restorative practice referred as Victim-Offender Dialogue or Conferencing. It requires participation of both individuals. The program is voluntary.

General Outcomes

AGREEMENTS MAY INCLUDE: LETTERS OF APOLOGY, RESTITUTION, VOLUNTEERING, COUNSELING, ATTENDING GROUP WORKSHOPS, PRESENTING IN CLASSES, MEETING FACE-TO-FACE (CIRCLE), ETC.

RJ is an approach, a way of doing justice.

RP RECOGNIZES THAT THERE ARE DIFFERENT WAYS FOR CLIENTS TO LEARN AND DEMONSTRATE ACCOUNTABILITY, AND THAT RJ CAN BE ONE OF THEM.
