## What is a Trauma-Informed Agency Champion?

Champions engage in two training tracks to develop skills for coaching agencies and schools in changing practices, policies, and culture to address adversity and support resiliency.

#### Who is a good fit for the program?

This program is intended for ACEs & Resiliency Fellows to continue their training as expert presenters and refine skills as action coaches. Other community members with similar ACE or trauma-informed training are also invited to participate.

#### What will I learn?

- Refined skills as an ACE Interface presenter (with a special refresher session with Laura Porter).
- How to develop an organizational action plan and utilize traumainformed agency assessment tools.
- Coaching skills to partner with school or community teams in implementing trauma-informed strategies.


