David Rose reported out some highlights from his trip to Walla Walla, Washington, including visiting the campus and meeting the principal who were the subject of the movie Paper Tigers. His

team learned of strategies and foundational philosophies around ACES. Some of the key points are children are resilient and resiliency is key, connection with at least one adult as well as the agency relationships with clients. David discussed the need to work as a team with sites individually once staff is educated about ACES. David uses the Nadine Burke Harris TED Talk which discusses ACES. Trauma-Informed education does not mean teachers become counselors and knowledge of ACES is synthesised for each school based on site demographics.

Michelle Dominguez, Counseling Services Coordinator and CHAT Program Assistant for CPI was introduced as interim Secretary.

Kate Jenkins shared her Treasurer's report. The Sonoma County ACEs Connection account currently has \$5,195.03 in the account. \$1,000 was paid to CPI for Ripple Effect.

Eric Lofchie, Trauma-Informed Educationals Services Director and New Directions Principal discussed his experience at the Beyond Consequences Seminar in St. Louis. Eric discussed the potential to put on a conference in Sacramento.
