Trauma Recovery Empowerment Model for Men

The Trauma Recovery & Empowerment Model for Men is intended for male trauma survivors, particularly those with exposure to physical or sexual violence. The model employs cognitive restructuring, psycho-educational and skills training techniques focusing specifically on how men understand and respond to trauma. This model has been implemented in mental health, substance abuse, co-occurring disorders and criminal justice settings and appropriate for a full range of disciplines.

The M-TREM manual guides group leaders through a 24-session trauma recovery process. The workshop will feature Lori Beyer, MSW, MSWAC who is the supervisory trauma clinician and lead trainer at Community Connections. She was one of the lead clinicians working with Dr. Maxine Harris who developed the model.

Ms. Beyer has over 23 years of experience working with adults who are dually diagnosed with a serious mental illness and substance abuse disorder, and have histories of homelessness and violent victimization.
