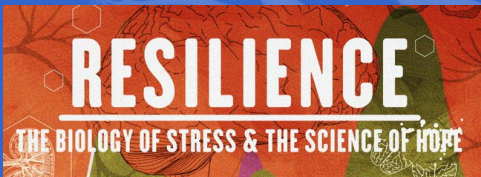

The ACE study and related research quantified the biological effects of stress and suffering.
