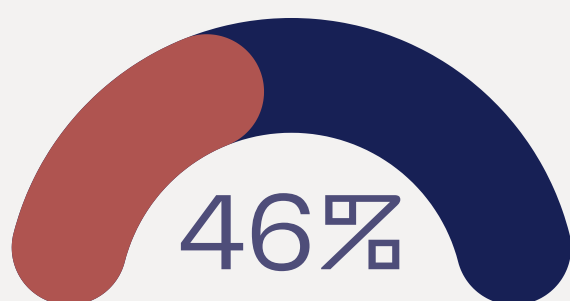

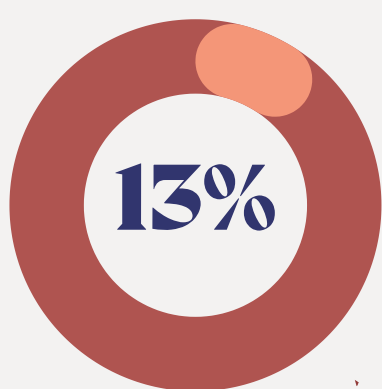
There are more ways to decline consent besides verbally saying “no”

(Pereira & Thompson, 2021)

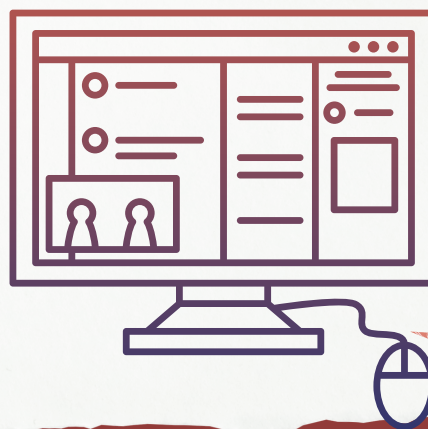
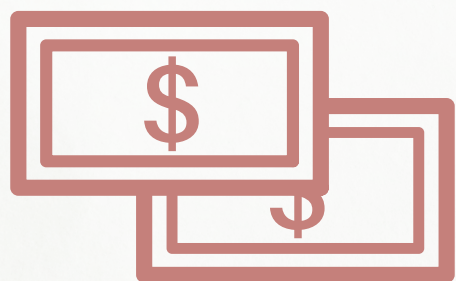


13% of students reported experiencing sexual assault at one point in their time on campus
