COMPREHENSIVE LIST OF SERVICES UNDER CREO

CREO is dedicated to providing outreach and health engagement services to Latino /Hispanic individuals & families residing in Yolo County, with particular emphasis given to residents in rural enclaves of Yolo County struggling with access to mental health services.

PRIMARY CARE SERVICES

Age(s): 18+

Eligibility: CommuniCare Health Center patients who are uninsured or underinsured.

Description: New patients who are screened and approved for CREO can access primary care services by establishing their primary care at one of our CommuniCare Health Center sites and not already be establish with another CommuniCare provider. Patients who are already CommuniCare patients and assigned to Lorraine Lunden may access primary care services free of charge.



BEHAVIORAL HEALTH COUNSELING

Age(s): 18+

Eligibility: CommuniCare Health Center patients who are uninsured or underinsured.

Description: 8-12 short-term solution focused therapy sessions with the intent of assisting patients develop coping strategies to address their current situations.

CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES

Eligibility: CommuniCare Health Center patients who are uninsured or underinsured.

Description: Case management services are available to assist patients connect to resources that will better assist patients with managing his/her health. Resources and referrals to CommuniCare programs and outside community agencies are made in order to better support the patient's care plan. The CREO care coordinator serves as a bridge between the patient, the medical team, and community resources.



PROMOTORA

Description: Provide culturally appropriate services and serves as a patient advocate, educator, mentor and outreach worker.
