Nurturing Parents, Nurturing Families (NPNF)	 NPNF is an evidence-based parent education program NPNF has been designed to enhance parent-child attachments by increasing parental knowledge, authenticity, empathy, and the capacity for sensitive responsiveness in a safe and supportive environment. NPNF is administered as a group-based program or through more specialized individual sessions (Spanish and English). 	CWS, sliding scale		
Teen/Young Parenting	 Parenting for Young Parents: Nurturing Skills for Teen Parents is an evidence-based program that uses the Active Parenting for Teens curriculum. Nurturing Skills for Teen Parents can be offered in 12-16 sessions (either group or individually). 	CWS, sliding scale		



Co – Parenting	 Improve parental communication and interactions and increase positive cooperative parenting. For parents who are no longer maintaining a couple's relationship. Youth and parents learn skills to help process, manage and resolve distressing thoughts, feelings and behaviors related to trauma; and enhance safety, growth, parenting skills, and family communication 	EPSDT, Juvenile Probation, sliding scale	
Cognitive Behavioral Interventions for Substance Abuse (CBI-SA)	 CBI-SA is a high dosage cognitive-behavioral group intervention. CBI-SA teaches strategies for avoiding substance abuse and emphasizes skill building activities for promoting cognitive, social, emotional and coping skills development. Individual Youth Therapy	 Cognitive behavioral therapy, psycho-education, relaxation techniques, emotion regulation skills and cognitive coping techniques.
